

GENERAL CONDITIONS

1.—BAGGAGE

(A) FREE ALLOWANCE—30 pounds.

(B) EXCESS BAGGAGE—To conform with the Department of Commerce regulations as to gross weights, baggage will be handled as follows: Whenever possible, Bowen Air Lines, Incorporated, will carry baggage in excess of thirty pounds on a basis of ½ of 1% of air fare per pound. The minimum charge will be 25¢, payable at the initial airport.

(C) MAXIMUM WEIGHT AND MEASUREMENT—Bowen Air Lines, Incorporated, reserves the right to refuse to transport, more than the free allowance and, also, reserves the right to refuse to transport any piece of baggage exceeding 1½ cubic feet in size. Representatives will gladly turn over baggage to express company for handling. Special arrangements must be made for baggage in excess of 30 pounds or over a cubical content of 1½ cubic feet.

2.—RESERVATIONS

All seats are reserved and no positive reservation will be made except on purchase of ticket. Persons purchasing round trip tickets are cautioned that return portion of tickets cannot be honored unless proper reservation has been made for the return trip.

3.—TICKETS

Purchasable at leading hotels and at air ports, Fort Worth, Dallas, Houston, Oklahoma City, Tulsa, Austin and San Antonio. Western Union or Postal will make reservations and deliver tickets without extra charge.

4.—CANCELLATIONS

No ticket will be accepted for cancellation later than two hours prior to schedule departure called for on reservation.

5.—CHILDREN'S FARES

Infants under two years of age carried free, when accompanied by parent or guardian, not occupying seat to the exclusion of other patrons. Full fare applies to children not classified as infants.

6.—PASSENGER CONDITIONS

The company reserves the right to cancel booking before passage or enroute, when in the judgment of its representative, same is for the safety of its passengers. Pilot may at any point enroute insist on the removal of any passenger for safety or other cause. The company does not guarantee to complete a schedule, or to do so on scheduled time. In all events, the passenger's sole recourse shall be the recovery of the portion of the fare paid as distance untraveled bears to the schedule of flight.

8.—ANIMALS

Animals will not be carried except by special arrangement.
