IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PASSENGERS

The 24-HOUR CLOCK system is used in this timetable

- (1) **Terms and Conditions of Carriage.** An extract from the conditions under which Imperial Airways undertakes to carry passengers and baggage will be found inside the cover of every air-ticket issued by the Company. The Company's *Conditions of Carriage* may be inspected at any office of Imperial Airways
- (2) **Alterations.** This timetable, which gives an indication of average times of journey, cancels all previous issues, and is subject to alteration without notice

TICKET REGULATIONS

(3) **Reservations.** Seats should be booked in advance, and the principal travel agents can reserve a seat provided that accommodation be available. The cost of any telegrams or trunk telephone calls in connexion with reservations will be charged to the passenger. Applications from intending passengers by telegram are only effected on the receipt of a telegraphic remittance, or the remittance by return of post. In no instance can accommodation be held in reply to a telegram or to a telephone message to the exclusion of other passengers who definitely wish to travel and are prepared to take up their tickets

Provisional reservations will be made only upon the payment of a deposit of 25 per cent. of the full fare. Such reservations automatically lapse unless the full fare is paid two clear days before departure. The 25 per cent. deposit will be transferred to any other service or will be refunded (less any cable or telegraphic expenses) if the passenger be unable to travel, or if accommodation be not available on the service on which a seat is desired

(4) **Cancellations.** In the event of a passenger wishing to cancel or to transfer a reservation and giving less than 24 hours' notice of this intention, the full fare may be forfeited or a transfer fee be charged.

(5) **Return Tickets.** A return ticket does not give the holder any preferential claim to accommodation. Reservations for a return journey must be effected in the same way as for a single journey

(a) **Refunds.**—If no accommodation has been reserved, and should the passenger be unable to use the return half of a ticket, then the difference between the single and the return fares will be refunded

(b) A passenger who does not pay the return fare at the time of buying a ticket for the outward journey, cannot afterwards be put upon the same footing as the holder of a return ticket

(c) Return tickets are available for use on the return journey any day within the period of their validity

(6) **Children.** Children under three years of age and accompanied by an adult will be charged 10 per cent. (ten per cent.) of the fare. Those between three and seven years of age are carried at half the standard fare. The free baggage allowance of 15 kgs. is available for children over three years, but there is no free allowance for children if under that age

(7) **Fares.** The fare applicable to any journey is that which is published in the currency of the country of embarkation, after conversion, if necessary, to the currency of the country of purchase

TRANSPORT BETWEEN THE CITY AND THE AIR PORT

(8) **Passenger Cars.** Transport from the station of departure to the Air Port and *vice versa* is provided without extra charge

(9) **Departure.** Passengers must be at the Air Port, or at the car departure station sufficiently in advance of the advertised time of departure as services cannot be delayed for passengers whose arrival leaves insufficient time to complete embarkation formalities for a punctual departure of the service

BAGGAGE INFORMATION

(10) **Baggage.** Fifteen kilogrammes (33 lbs.) of baggage are carried free of charge for each passenger when travelling on the services enumerated in this timetable. A concession is made for parties travelling together, whereby the allowance for the baggage may be 'bulked.' Excess baggage can accompany passengers (subject to the permissible load of the air-liner not being exceeded), but every kilogramme (2.2 lbs.) in excess of this weight is charged for at the rates shown. On certain routes this charge is reduced after the first 15 kgs. excess, of which further information can be obtained from any of the Company's offices. *Heavy baggage can be sent in advance on certain routes at cheap rates.* Passengers' baggage must contain personal effects only. By Customs regulations all merchandise must be declared separately as freight, and entered on the aircraft manifest

(11) **Registration of Baggage.** Passengers' baggage is registered and labelled and a receipt is issued before departure. Passengers should guard against losing this receipt, or they may have difficulty in obtaining their baggage

(12) **The Carriage of Livestock.** Passengers are unable to carry with them, either as their personal baggage or in the saloon of the air-liner, any dog, cat, bird or any other animal, and all animals must be transported as freight

GENERAL INFORMATION

(13) **Passports.** Passengers are reminded that passports should be carried on the person. Imperial Airways or its agents will be pleased to obtain passports or visas on request provided that reasonable notice be given. *British, French and Belgian subjects do not require passports for week-end trips between London and Paris, Le Touquet, Belgian Coast, Ostend and Brussels*

(15) **Hotels.** The names of personally inspected and recommended hotels in Great Britain and in all countries served by Imperial Airways are available at each of the Company's offices for the information of passengers. Imperial Airways will arrange hotel reservations if desired

(14) **Meals.** On the London-Paris services the air-liners are provided with a fully equipped restaurant, from which stewards serve breakfast, lunch, tea, dinner, or light refreshments as desired. There is also a bar supplying a full range of wines, spirits and other beverages

On other European services refreshment baskets can be provided if ordered at the time of booking
