

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PASSENGERS

The 24-hour clock system is used in this time table

1 Conditions of Carriage An extract from the general conditions under which passengers are carried by Imperial Airways will be found in every air ticket. A copy of the *General Conditions of Carriage* may be inspected at any of the Company's offices, or airports

2 Connections This time table, which is subject to alteration without notice, gives an indication of average times of journey. Connections with services operated by other air lines or by other forms of transport are not guaranteed

3 Departure Passengers must arrive at the car departure station or at the airport sufficiently in advance of the advertised time of departure to enable the examination of passports and baggage registration formalities to be completed. **THE SERVICES CANNOT BE DELAYED FOR PASSENGERS WHOSE ARRIVAL LEAVES INSUFFICIENT TIME TO COMPLETE THESE FORMALITIES**

TICKET REGULATIONS

4 Reservations Seats should be booked in advance, either through a travel agent or with any office of the Company. Telegrams or trunk telephone calls in connexion with reservations are at the passenger's expense. Accommodation can in no case be reserved definitely without payment of the fare. Provisional reservations may be made upon payment of a deposit of 25 per cent. of the fare, but such reservations lapse automatically unless the balance is paid two clear days before the day of departure

5 Cancellations and Refunds (a) By the passenger. If the ticket be surrendered not less than twenty-four hours before departure, the fare (less any telephone or telegraphic expenses) will be refunded

If a reservation be cancelled less than twenty-four hours before departure and the air liner is fully booked, no refund will be allowed unless the accommodation is re-sold. If the air liner be not fully booked or the accommodation be re-sold, the fare will be refunded, less a cancellation fee of 6s. and any telephone or telegraphic expenses

(b) By the Company. The Company reserves the right to cancel any flight or part of a flight whenever such action is deemed advisable or necessary. In any event the passenger's sole redress shall be the recovery of the unused portion of the fare

6 Transferred Bookings Bookings may be transferred to a subsequent service operated by the same company or companies provided that accommodation is available, on payment of telephone or telegraphic expenses

7 Return Tickets A return ticket entitles the holder to a preferential claim to accommodation. Return ticket holders must reserve their accommodation in the same way as passengers making a single journey. To secure the reduction allowed upon return tickets the return fare must be paid when buying the ticket for the outward journey. If a passenger be unable to use the return half of the ticket, the difference between the single and return fare will be refunded, provided that the regulations regarding cancellation have been observed

8 Children Children under three years of age, when accompanied by an adult, will be charged 10 per cent. of the fare. Those between three and seven years of age (or younger children occupying a separate seat) are charged at half fare. The free baggage allowance of fifteen kilograms (33 lb.) is available for children over three but there is no free allowance for children under that age

9 Foreign Currencies The fare for any journey is that which is published in the currency of the country of embarkation. Payment may be accepted in other currencies after conversion at the exchange rate prevailing at the time of booking

10 Passenger Cars Except where otherwise indicated the cost of car transport between the city and the airport and vice versa is included in the air fare

BAGGAGE INFORMATION

11 Allowances and Charges Every passenger is allowed fifteen kilograms (33 lb.) of baggage free. Baggage in excess of the free allowance is charged at the rates shown in the time table. The free allowances for two or more persons travelling together may be 'bulked.' Heavy baggage can be sent in advance on certain routes at reduced rates

12 Customs Regulations Only personal effects can be carried as baggage. All merchandise (including traveller's samples) must be declared as cargo, and the appropriate freight charges are payable

13 Registration of Baggage Baggage is registered and labelled and a baggage check is issued before departure. Passengers should guard against losing their baggage or if they will have difficulty in obtaining their baggage at the end of the journey

14 Live Animals No dog, cat, bird or live animal of any kind may be carried in the passenger cabins, or as baggage. There are special arrangements for the transport of livestock as freight on most services

PASSPORT INFORMATION

15 Passports Passengers are reminded that passports should be carried with them and not packed in their baggage. They are advised to verify the validity and the accuracy of their passports, endorsements and visas, as the Company cannot accept any responsibility for the consequences of non-compliance with the regulations

Imperial Airways or its agents are ready to assist passengers to obtain passports or visas at reasonable notice and on payment of expenses

16 'No Passport' Tickets Between England and France, England and Belgium, and England and Holland, return tickets for day or week-end trips without passports are available under certain conditions. Full information may be obtained from any travel agent or from the Company

17 Currency Restrictions Passengers are reminded that the movement of money into or out of certain countries (Germany, Greece, and Italy in particular) is restricted by law

GENERAL INFORMATION

18 Meals On most services of Imperial Airways breakfast, lunch, tea, and dinner or light refreshments as desired may be obtained during the flight. There is also a bar supplying wines, spirits and other beverages. On air liners which do not carry a buffet, refreshment baskets can be provided if ordered in advance

19 Hotels The names of personally inspected and recommended hotels in Great Britain and in all countries served by Imperial Airways are available at each of the Company's offices for the convenience of regular travellers

20 Season Travel Vouchers For the information of passengers Imperial Airways issues books of vouchers at reduced rates. These vouchers may be exchanged for the European services of any air company which is a member of the International Air Traffic Association

21 Bulk Travel Vouchers For the convenience of firms regularly using air travel for their employees, Imperial Airways issues bulk travel vouchers at reduced rates. Details on application to any office of Imperial Airways, or from the principal travel agents

IMPORTANT NOTE

22 Cameras Passengers are warned that the carriage or use of cameras in the air is prohibited by law when flying over certain countries. In order to avoid difficulties with the authorities, passengers must declare cameras to an official of the Company before embarkation, and in case of a breach of the regulations in any State will be held personally liable by the authorities of the State concerned
