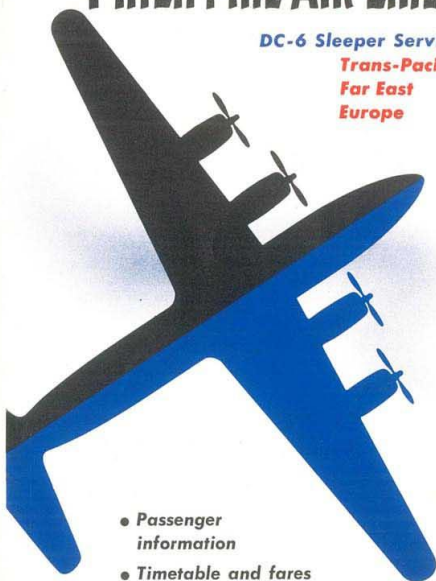

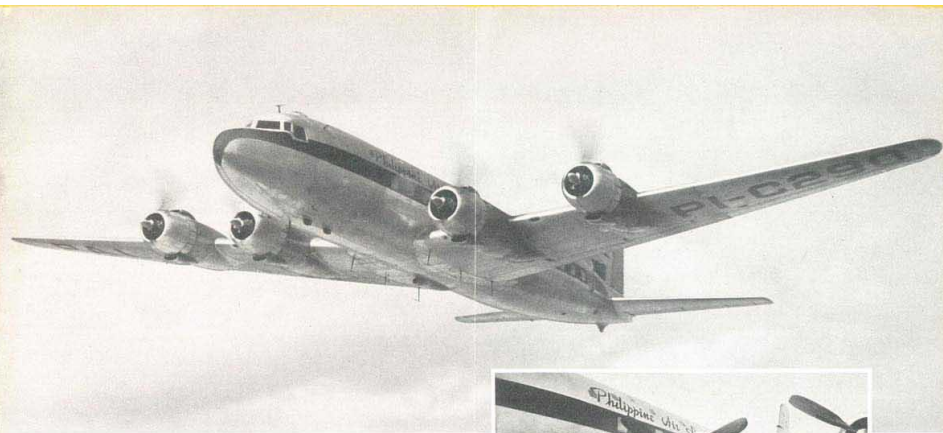

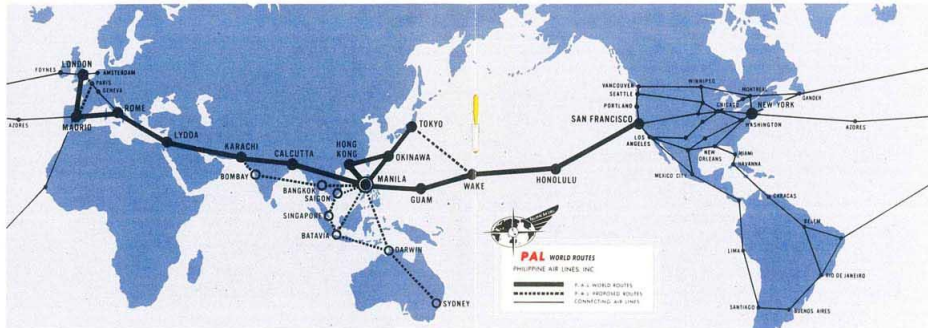

### Round-the-World Air Fare—\$1700.00

By special arrangement with other air carriers, Philippine Air Lines offers a round-the-world routing in either direction from any regularly scheduled stop. The fare of \$1,700 includes portions operated by other air carriers.

### Philippines Inter-Island Service

Philippine Air Lines is the designated air carrier of the Philippine Republic. A fleet of more than 35 planes provides daily service to all major points in the Islands. For schedule and fare information, consult any P.A.L. office or representative.

## Baggage

Baggage allowance, including all types of luggage, typewriters, parcels, briefcases, etc., is limited to 66 pounds (30 kilos) per passenger. Personal articles carried by passengers, such as overcoats, umbrellas and pocket cameras are regarded as personal weight and are not weighed in as "baggage." Inflammable articles are prohibited in passengers' baggage.

**Excess baggage, if allowed, will be charged** for at 1% of the one-way fare per kilo (2.2 pounds). If you have luggage which need not accompany you on the plane, you may ship via P.A.L. Air Cargo. Any P.A.L. representative will be pleased to assist you.

## Customs

Baggage generally is not inspected on leaving the United States although certain restrictions are in effect on firearms and some types of food. Customs officers of the various countries inspect baggage on arrival at destination. Used personal articles are usually admitted free of duty. For details you should contact the proper consulates who can give up-to-date information as to what may be brought into their respective countries. The U. S. Customs now allows duty free a \$400.00 valuation to returning residents. Baggage or articles purchased abroad arriving later by surface transportation may be declared at time of entry. Proper receipts should be retained by passengers in order to receive this exemption.

## Insurance

Trip insurance is available at all travel agents or P.A.L. offices. Extremely low rates covering all eventualities are due directly to the safety of air-travel.

## What time is it?

The question of time and date may puzzle you during your flight. Here is how you can figure it out, based on local standard times:

When it is 12 noon Sunday, Greenwich Mean Time (GMT), it is:

0700 (7:00 AM) Sunday in New York  
0400 (4:00 AM) Sunday in San Francisco  
0200 (2:00 AM) Sunday in Honolulu  
2100 (9:00 PM) Sunday in Tokyo  
2000 (8:00 PM) Sunday in Manila  
1800 (6:00 PM) Sunday in Calcutta  
1400 (2:00 PM) Sunday in Cairo  
1300 (1:00 PM) Sunday in Rome  
1200 (12:00 Noon) Sunday in Madrid

If Daylight Saving Time is in effect, add one hour to the local standard time affected. All departure and arrival times in this schedule are local standard times.

## Stopover privileges

All passengers of P.A.L. have stopover privileges at any city served by the air line and specified in their tickets, subject to local immigration regulations and time limit of tickets. Tickets are valid for a period of one year from original date of issue.

## Dogs trained to lead the blind

Dogs trained to lead the blind, if properly muzzled and harnessed, may be carried in the passenger cabin without charge when accompanying a person dependent upon the dog. The dog may not occupy a seat and must be kept at the feet of the passenger. P.A.L. will not be responsible if such dog is refused entry into, or passage through, any country or territory.

## Arrival at departure point

Passengers must arrive at airports sufficiently in advance of scheduled departure time of aircraft to permit the completion of governmental or other formalities and the checking of baggage. Passengers originating in the United States are required to check in at city ticket office, 212 Stockton Street, San Francisco, two hours before scheduled departure time of aircraft, or at San Francisco International Terminal one hour before departure time.

## Air cargo

Philippine Air Lines flies thousands of pounds of important and valuable air freight between the United States, the Orient and Europe. This important service offers noteworthy advantages to all types of industries. Here are some of the "extras" you receive as an air freight shipper: extra speed, extra service, extra handling care and extra savings. The versatility of this service is extremely broad. Not only are the lighter goods such as jewelry, furs and hose being carried by international air cargo, but also products of most manufacturers, importers and exporters.

The examples shown below are typical rates per pound for less than 100 pounds. Reductions of more than 25% apply to shipments of 100 pounds or more.
