

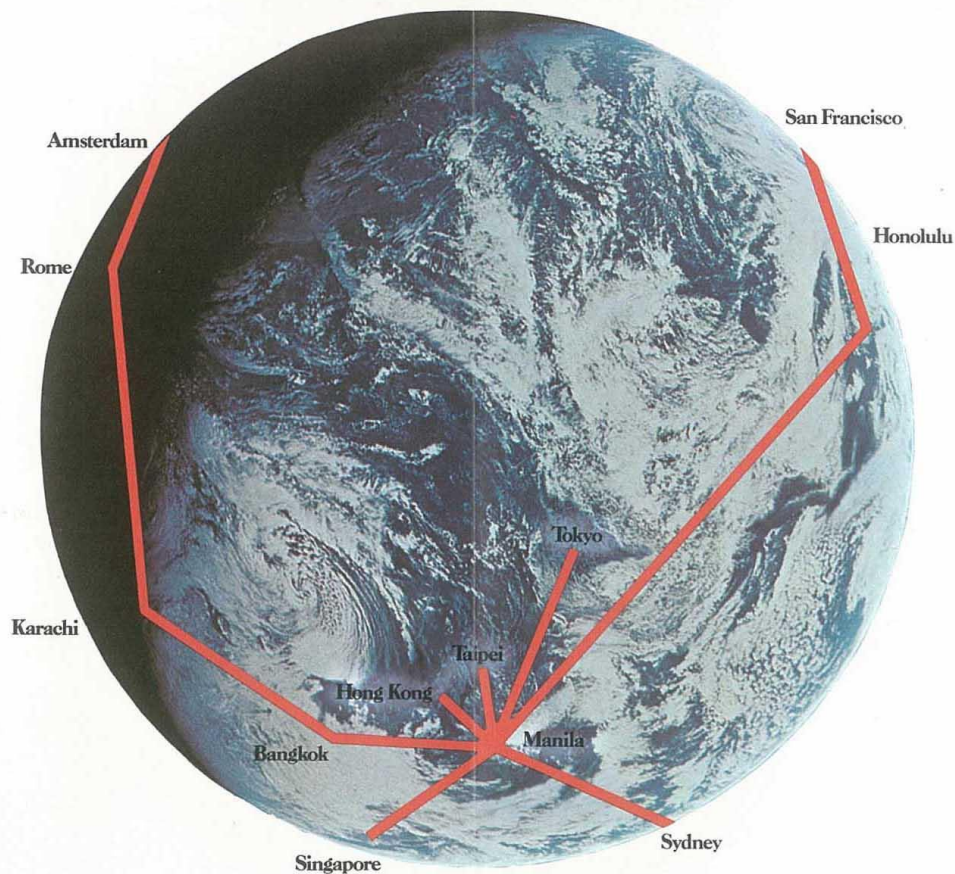

Passenger Information

CONDITIONS OF CARRIAGE. Your ticket is issued subject to our General Conditions of Carriage for Passengers and Baggage which may be inspected at any Philippine Airlines Office.

RESERVATIONS. Reservations may be made through your travel agent or directly with Philippine Airlines. Be sure to confirm your Onward or Return reservations upon arriving at your stopover or transfer points and destination.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS. Philippine Airlines and its agents will gladly provide information regarding travel permits, passports, health certificates, and other necessary documents required for your trip.

CHECK-IN. Passengers are requested to be at the airport Check-In Counter at least 1 hour prior to scheduled departure time.

FREE BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE. Your ticket entitles you to free baggage allowance as follows: Economy Class, 20 kilograms or 44 lbs. First Class, 30 kilograms or 66 lbs.

Children paying half fare are entitled to the same free baggage allowance as adults. Infants traveling on 10% of the adult fare are not entitled to any free baggage allowance.

Personal articles carried with you into the cabin, such as a lady's handbag, an overcoat, an umbrella or walking stick, a small camera, a pair of binoculars, infant's food for consumption in flight and infant's carrying basket, and a reasonable amount of reading matter for the flight may be carried without charge, in addition to the free baggage allowance.

RESTRICTED ARTICLES. Articles such as the following shall not be carried in passengers' baggage: Compressed gasses (flammable, non-flammable and Poisonous); Corrosives (such as acids,

wet batteries); Explosives, munitions, fireworks and articles which are easily ignited; Flammable liquids and solids (such as flammable aerosols, lighter or heating fuels, matches); Oxidizing materials; Poisons; Radioactive materials; Other restricted articles (such as mercury, magnetic material, offensive or irritating materials).

STOPOVERS. You may stopover at any scheduled stop on your flight or connecting point provided that arrangements for such stopovers have been made prior to your departure from the airport preceding the stopover point.

CONNECTING FLIGHTS. Manila is a center for international travel and you will find excellent connections to world-wide destinations as well as PAL's direct flights to Hongkong, Singapore, Taipei, Sydney, Tokyo, Bangkok, Karachi, Rome and Amsterdam, and 48 points throughout the Philippines.

CREDIT CARDS. Major credit cards are welcome at any PAL office or its travel agents — American Express, Diners Club International, Master Charge, Bank of America, Carte Blanche and Universal Air Travel Card.

TIME PAYMENT PLAN. PAL's convenient finance plan enables you to fly now — pay later. You pay only 10% of the fare before you depart — and you may take up to 24 months to complete the balance. This plan is available in the Philippines and the U.S.A.

PREPAID PLAN. Ask any ticket office of PAL or your travel agent about purchasing prepaid transportation for your friends and relatives.

IN-FLIGHT ENTERTAINMENT. First run motion pictures are featured on certain flights, along with multi-channel listening entertainment. In line with international agreement, there is a charge of \$2.50 per passenger for rental of headsets.

“The Philippines in a nutshell . . . where to go, what to do.”

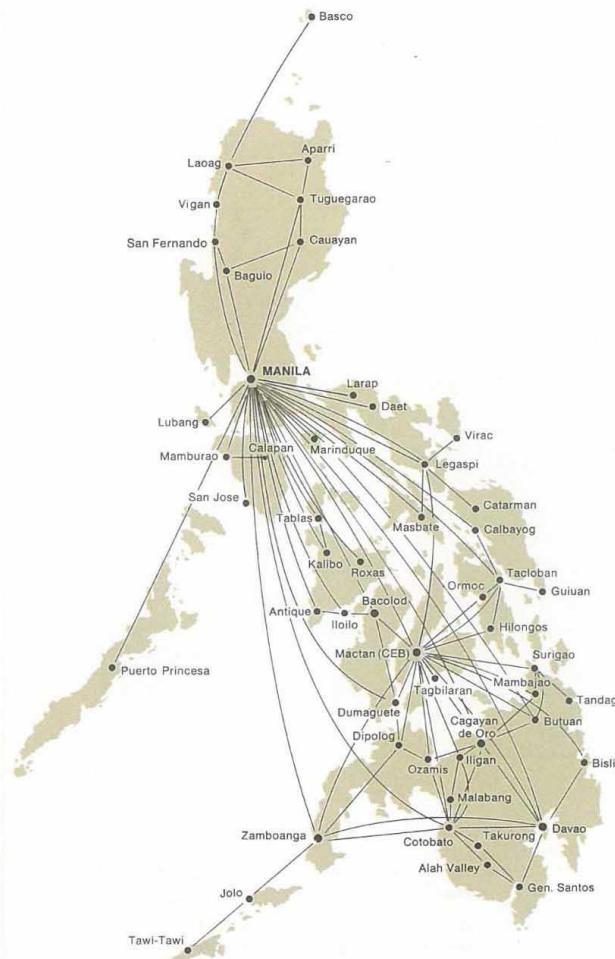
Within the green ambience that enfolds the Philippines is an intriguing blend of old and new, the east and west, fun and adventure . . . where there still are discoveries to be made. Held in suspension are the imprints of historical yesterdays . . . in Manila, the Walled City of Intramuros, with its ruins, historic churches and nunneries. Across the river from Intramuros is Quiapo where varied jeepneys bustle with frenetic zeal. The colorful markets . . . baskets laden with mangoes and other tropical fruit delicacies. Off palm-fringed Roxas Boulevard along Manila Bay where the sun sets with breath-taking splendor stands the new Cultural Center, stage and repository of the arts of Philippine and foreign origins. A mile away nestled within the “tourist belt” is the beautiful Rizal Park. Across the Pasig river is the stately and historic Malacanang Palace.

Drive out to the country. See the bamboo organ at Las Pinas, the only one of its kind in the world. Or take a refreshing cruise to Cielito Lindo in Laguna de Bay on a “banca.” Or watch a cockfight in Tagaytay midst the breath-taking panorama of Lake Taal.

Then there are the picture-postcard sights of Pagsanjan Falls, famous for its exciting rapids. The historic Corregidor. Baguio, city of pines and summer capital of the Philippines. Banawe rice terraces, one of the most amazing marvels of the world . . . mile upon endless mile of terraces carved on the mountainsides by the Ifugao thousands of years ago. Mayon Volcano, the world’s most perfect cone. Sulu, a world in itself . . . with villages on stilts, hanging gardens, boulevards winding through coconut groves, and the majestic Muslim vintas . . . rare and exotic fruits, wild orchids, shells, and exquisite pearls.

But reserve a day for festive Makati. Sample the “lechon,” roast suckling pig on a spit, coconut milk, rice cakes wrapped in banana leaves, duhat wine. Listen to lovers’ guitars strumming the “Kundimans.” Learn “tinikling,” the famous bamboo dance. Watch a haute couture show of creations made with pineapple and banana fabrics. Watch the world’s fastest game at the Jai Alai in the evening. Or, just watch the beautiful Filipinas, world acclaimed for their innate grace and charm.

If you missed any one of the more famous spots, make up for it by a visit to Nayong Pilipino (just a walk from the airport) a permanent exhibit of things Philippine . . . from artifacts to recreated architecture of life and culture from the northernmost part to the southernmost regions of the archipelago. In one sweeping glance — the Philippines in a nutshell.
