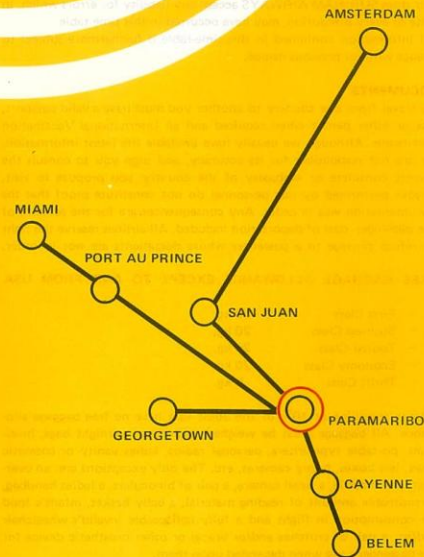

GENERAL INFORMATION

FARES

For fares and rules please contact your travel agent or SURINAM AIRWAYS' sales offices.

RECONFIRMATION OF RESERVATION

To ensure your continuing and return reservation, reconfirmation is required at least 72 hours before departure of your flight. Passengers travelling on apex-tickets are recommended to reconfirm at least 7 days before departure of their flight. In accordance with standard industry regulations, failure to reconfirm may result in the cancellation of your reservations. For phone numbers of reconfirmation offices see back page.

LIABILITY

SURINAM AIRWAYS does not accept any liability for damage suffered by passengers because of delay in the flight or failure to execute all or parts of a flight. Nor does SURINAM AIRWAYS accept any liability for errors which, in spite of every precaution, may have occurred in this time table. All information contained in this time-table is furthermore subject to change without previous notice.

DOCUMENTS

To travel from one country to another you must have a valid passport, visa or other permit when required and an International Vaccination Certificate. Although we usually have available the latest information, we are not responsible for its accuracy, and urge you to consult the nearest consulate or embassy of the country you propose to visit. Checks performed by our personnel do not constitute proof that the documentation was in order. Any consequences are for the account of the passenger, cost of deportation included. All airlines reserve the right to refuse carriage to a passenger whose documents are not in order.

FREE BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE EXCEPT TO AND FROM USA

F = First Class : 30 kg.
C = Business Class : 20 kg.
M = Tourist Class : 20 kg.
Y = Economy Class : 20 kg.
T = Thrift Class : 5 kg.

Infants travelling at 10% of the adult fare have no free baggage allowance. All baggage must be weighed, including overnight bags, brief-cases, portable typewriters, personal radios, ladies vanity or cosmetic cases, hat boxes, heavy cameras, etc. The only exceptions are: an overcoat, an umbrella, a small camera, a pair of binoculars, a ladies handbag, a reasonable amount of reading material, a baby basket, infant's food for consumption in flight and a fully collapsible invalid's wheelchair and/or a pair of crutches and/or braces or other prosthetic device for the passenger's use when depended upon them.

EXCESS BAGGAGE CHARGES

All baggage in excess of the above free allowance will be charged for at fixed rates per kilogram varying per route to be flown.

CABIN BAGGAGE

One piece of baggage, the dimension of which not to exceed 8 x 14 x 21 inches (20 x 35 x 53 cm) may be carried in the cabin by each full or half fare paying passenger.

BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE TO AND FROM U.S.A.

1. FIRST CLASS

CABIN BAGGAGE

One piece of baggage the sum of the 3 dimensions of which does not exceed 115 cms (45 inches) can be accepted as cabin baggage, provided such bag can be stowed in the underseat space and it is carried on board by the passenger.

BAGGAGE

Every passenger is entitled to carry four (4) pieces of baggage for which no extra charge will have to be paid but the sum of the 3 outside dimensions of each bag must not exceed 158 cms (62 inches). The maximum weight of each bag may not exceed 32 kgs (70 lbs.).

2. ECONOMY CLASS

CABIN BAGGAGE

One piece of baggage the sum of the 3 dimensions of which does not exceed 115 cms (45 inches) can be accepted as cabin baggage, provided such bag can be stowed in the underseat space and it is carried on board by the passenger.

BAGGAGE

Every passenger is entitled to carry two (2) pieces of baggage for which no extra charge will have to be paid but the sum of the 3 outside dimensions of each bag must not exceed 158 cms (62 inches). The total sum of the 3 outside dimensions of both bags must not exceed 272 cms (107 inches). The maximum weight of each bag may not exceed 32 kgs (70 lbs.).

EXCESS BAGGAGE

Baggage that is delivered in excess of that provided above will be accepted only upon payment of charges with a minimum of US\$ 50.-

CARGO

Passengers who want to transport more than 2 pieces in excess of their normal allowance, or have pieces exceeding the dimensions or the weight afore-mentioned, have to ship these goods as cargo. These goods will be forwarded as soon as possible.

IDENTIFICATION

Remove old baggage tags of former flights to avoid possible misrouting, and lock your suitcases to prevent them from falling open. For the purpose of easy identification, please mark all baggage - also that which is kept in the cabin with your name and address. Labels are available at all SURINAM AIRWAYS' check-in counters.

BAGGAGE LIABILITY AND CLAIMS

Irregularities with regard to your baggage must be reported immediately on arrival to a SURINAM AIRWAYS' staff member or representative at the airport. Claims, if any, must be filed in writing within seven days after receipt of baggage. Liability for loss, delay or damage to baggage is limited. The maximum liability is US\$ 20 per kilo checked baggage and US\$ 400 per passenger for unchecked baggage.

INSURANCE

You may insure your baggage at reasonable rates. Full details can be obtained at SLM offices and authorised travel agencies.

CONDITIONS OF CARRIAGE

All transportation by SLM is subject to SLM's general conditions of carriage which are filed in the registry of the District Court of Paramaribo and may be inspected at any SLM office.
