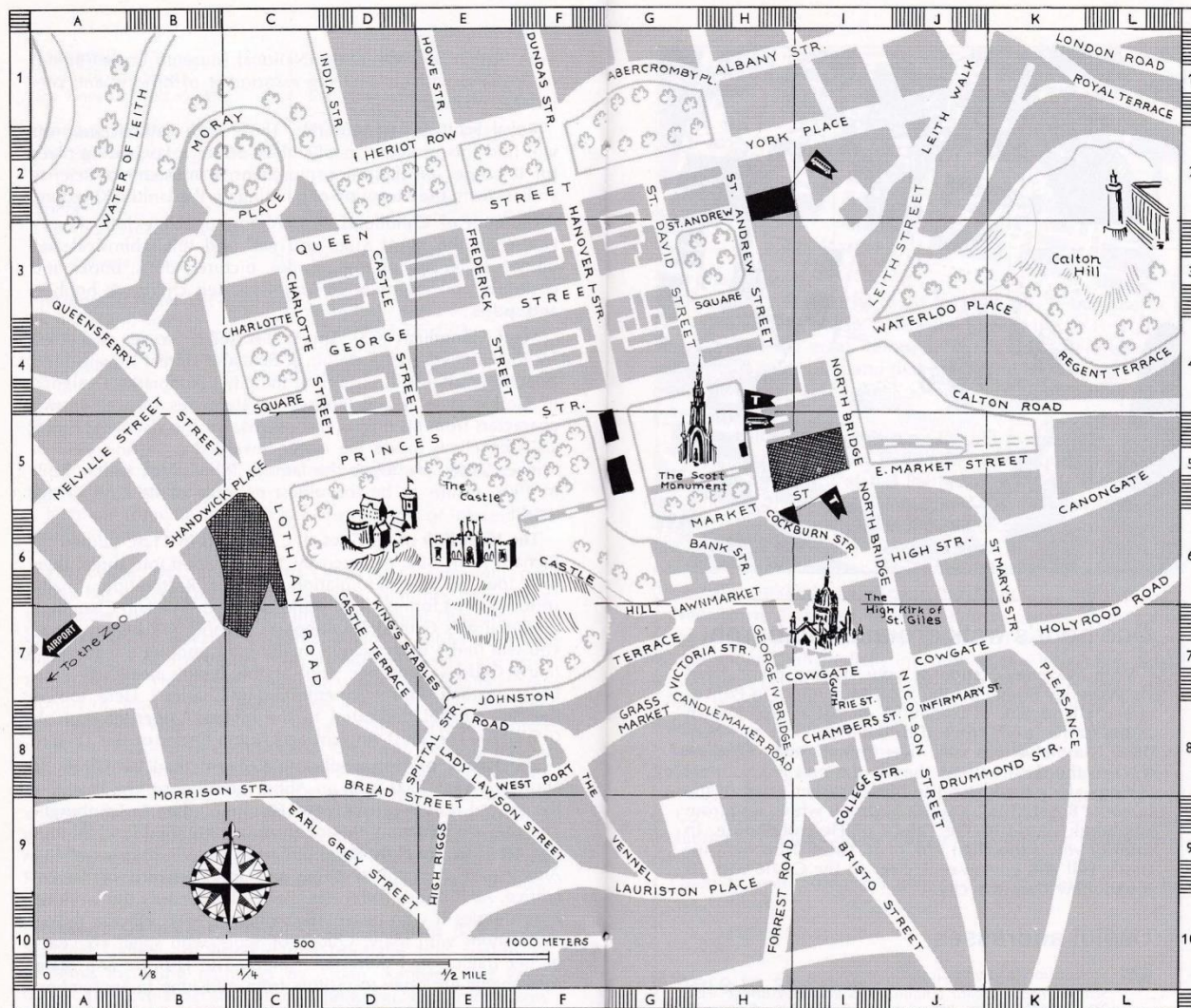


Edinburgh Glasgow
