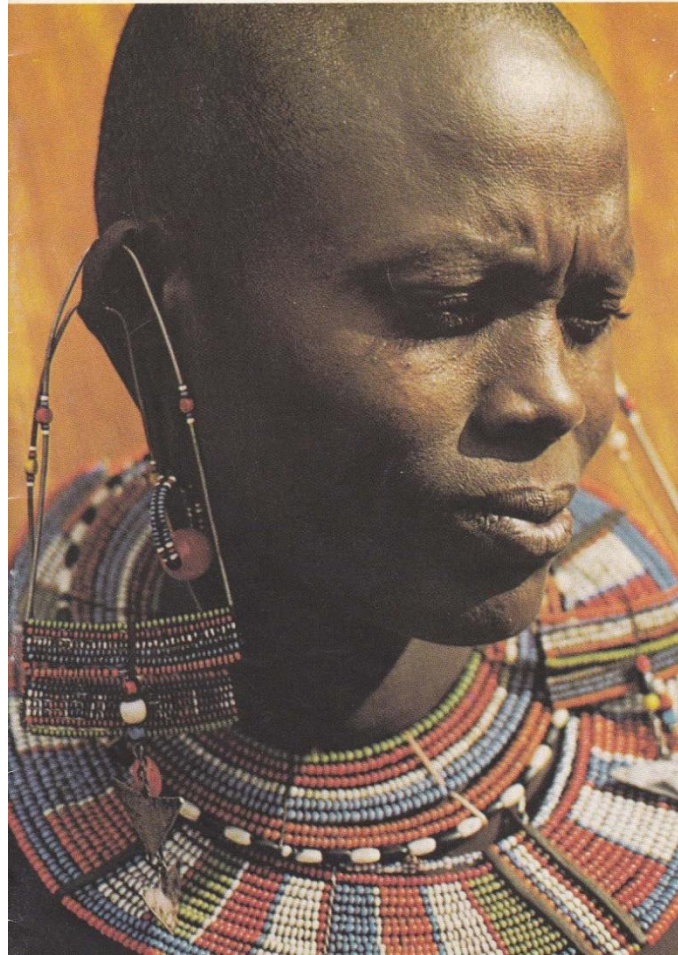

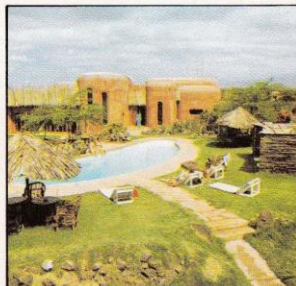
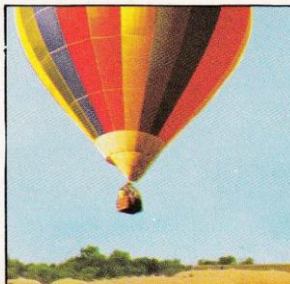

Serena Beach Hotel

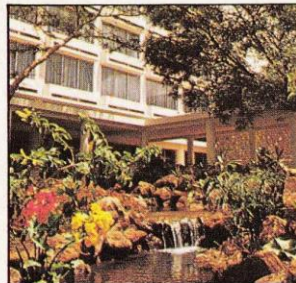
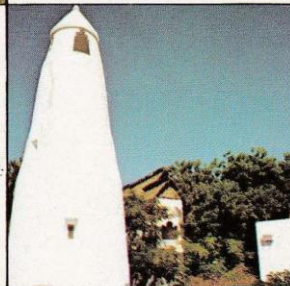
