The easiest and most practical way to reach Tijuana Airport is to drive your own car direct to the terminal. By using U.S. Highway 101 or 395, it's no more than a 31/2 hour drive from just about anywhere in Southern California. After reaching San Diego, continue on for a few more miles to the U.S.-Mexico border. Tijuana airport is located just a short distance beyond.

Your Mexico flight has been scheduled to allow ample time for you to leave home after breakfast, stop for lunch at one of the many ocean-view restaurants along the way, and still reach the airport in time to clear the necessary Government formalities and prepare for your departure. No Customs or Immigration inspection is required when crossing the border into Mexico. Merely inform the official of your intention to clear at the airport.

Adjacent to the Tijuana airport is a 24-hour attended parking lot where you may leave your car for 75¢ a day, full coverage.

However, if you are reaching San Diego by transportation other than your own car, or if you plan to park your car in San Diego garage (average rate for 24 hours is \$1.00), you may check-in your tickets, luggage and arrange for your Tourist Card at the Aeronaves office, 131 Broadway. Courtesy Limousine Service leaves that office at 1:15 p.m. PDST, and will carry you as far as the border where you will transfer to waiting Mexican transportation for the airport. Your luggage will be carried direct from San Diego to Tijuana airport by special vehicle.

Similar procedure is performed on return flights, with the exception that you retain your luggage in your possession. Upon reaching the U.S.-Mexico border, a brief U.S. Customs inspection will be made.



# GENERAL PASSENGER INFORMATION

Domestic flights are those originating from the gateways of Tijuana, Nogales and C. Juarez. Baggage in excess of the free allowance will be charged for at the rate of 1% of the normal adult one-way First Class fare per kilo.

ARRIVAL AT AIRPORT OF EMBARKATION

Passengers on flights originating at border cities should arrive at the airport at least one full hour before scheduled departure time in order to complete necessary Government and Airline formalities.

CHILDREN'S FARE

Accompanied children 2 years of age or over, but under 12 years of age will be charged one-half the normal adult fare. Children over 12 will be charged full adult fare. One child under 2 years, not occupying a seat, will be carried free with each full-paying passenger. Additional children under 2 will be charged for at one-half the normal adult fare and may occupy a seat.

If claims for damaged baggage and/ or personal property are not filed at the airport immediately upon consumation of the flight,

such claims will not be accepted by the company unless proof is made that such damage countries proof is made that such damage occurred while the baggage was in the custody of Aeronaves de Mexico.

Aeronaves de Mexico will not be responsible for damage resulting from failure of planes to depart or arrive at times stated in this time table, nor for errors herein, nor for failure to make connection with planes of other airlines or of this company. Aeronaves de Mexico also reserves the right to change equipment, alter or cancel any of the schedules shown herein without prior notice.

REFUNDS

In the case where definite reservations have been made and are cancelled at the passenger's request, the fare will be refunded provided the passenger notifies Aeronaves de Mexico at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled departure time.
