GENERAL INFORMATION FOR PASSENGERS

1. ARRIVAL AT EMBARKATION POINTS

Passengers must arrive at the airport or terminal dispatch office (whichever is indicated at time booking is made) in time to permit the completion of governmental and other requirements before scheduled departure.

2. BAGGAGE

Passengers including children carried at 50% of fare, are permitted a free baggage allowance of 44lbs. excluding hand baggage. Children carried at 10% of fare are entitled to no free baggage allowance. Baggage in excess of the free allowance will be charged for at published excess baggage rates and can only be carried if space is available.

3. HEAVY BAGGAGE

Arrangements may be made for heavy baggage belonging to the passenger to be sent in advance or after the passenger has travelled either by air or surface transport.

4. BREAK OF JOURNEY

Passengers may break their journey at one or more places en route and retain the benefit of the through fare, provided notice of intention to do so is given at the time of booking the passage. Any hotel or other expenses so incurred are the responsibility of the passenger unless otherwise arranged prior to departure.

5. CAMERAS

Passengers are not allowed to take cameras with them in the aircraft. Declaration of all cameras must be made at the Customs before departure, and packed in the registered baggage which is not accessible during flight.

6. CANCELLATIONS

If notice of cancellation is received not less than 48 hours before scheduled time of departure, the fare, less a fee to cover normal expenses, will be refunded.

If a reservation is cancelled less than 48 hours no refund will be allowed unless the accommodation is resold, or the aircraft is not fully booked.

In cases where passengers fail to comply with the passport, currency, health and other regulations, and are thereby prevented from travelling, a refund of the fare may be refused, and the passenger may be called upon to bear expenses involved.

7. CURRENCY RESTRICTIONS

Passengers should make themselves fully aware of the regulations concerning these and applicable to the countries to which they are travelling.

8. HEALTH REGULATIONS

Most countries require valid certificates of inoculation and/or vaccination which are issued on a special international form. Please consult us on what is necessary and attach certificates to your passport.

9. PASSPORTS, PERMITS AND VISAS

Passengers should be in possession of a valid passport and any other necessary visas, permits or endorsements. We or our agents will only be too pleased to help or advise you on these matters. Carry your passport with you when travelling. Do not pack it.

10. RESERVATIONS

Passengers should make their reservation and pay their fare or a deposit well in advance in order to ensure a passage on a specific date. Upon arriving at destination or transfer point it is advisable to confirm the return or onward reservation.

11. TRANSPORT

Transport is provided free of charge for all passengers from the town office to the airport and vice versa. Passengers will depart from town office 60 minutes prior to the schedule take-off.

12. TICKETS, AND CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

Tickets are issued to passengers subject to these Regulations and to our General Conditions of Carriage of Passengers and Baggage, an extract of which appears on the reverse side of the ticket.

13. TICKET VALIDITY

a) One way ticket is only valid for the fixed destination and time as shown on the ticket. b) Return tickets benefit of a 10% reduction on the normal fares and are valid 6 months from date of departure.

14. TIME-TABLE

This Company disclaims any responsibility for unavoidable delays, missed connections, changes in time table and or temporary suspension of the Service.

15. FARES

Fares may be changed from time to time.

Fares Children and infants.

Infants under 2 years, if accompanied and not occupying a seat are charged 10% of the normal fare. Children from 2 to 12 years pay half fare.

16. ANIMALS

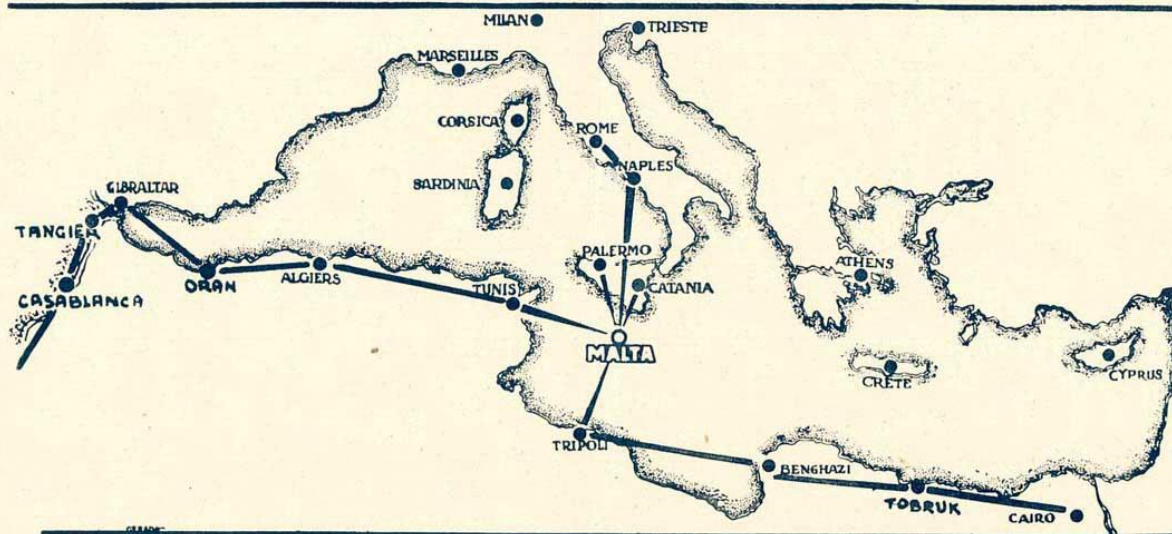
No animals may be carried on the aircraft unless by prior arrangement.
