

General Information for Passengers

CONDITIONS OF CARRIAGE

The carriage of passengers, baggage and cargo is subject to Hunting-Clan Air Transport Limited's Conditions of Carriage, which may be seen on request at any Hunting-Clan Office. The notes below are for guidance only.

RESERVATIONS AND CANCELLATIONS. Seats should be reserved as far in advance as possible through any Hunting-Clan Air Transport Booking Office or Agent. As there is a great demand for seats, please let us know as early as possible if you cannot take up your reservations. Cancellation charges apply on International services when passengers fail to take up seats they have reserved.

CHILDREN. One child under two years of age accompanied by an adult and not occupying a separate seat is carried at 10 per cent. of the adult fare. Additional children under two years and children of two years and under twelve years of age are carried at half the adult fare.

TICKETS. Your ticket contains important information concerning your journey; please examine it carefully.

PARTY TRAVEL. There are reduced fares for parties travelling together.

STUDENTS. Special reduced fares are available on certain services for students over 12 and under 26 years of age attending full-time school, college, university courses or other educational institutes when travelling to and from their homes or visiting their parents. Full information obtainable on request.

PASSPORTS AND VISAS. Hunting-Clan Air Transport or its Agents will gladly provide on request information regarding Passports or any visa required for your journey, but you must ensure personally that these documents are in order, because the carrier cannot accept responsibility for the consequences of any irregularity. You will have to show your passport during your journey, so please carry it with you; do not pack it!

HEALTH CERTIFICATES. Certain countries require valid certificates of inoculation and/or vaccination. Please enquire well in advance whether any such certificates are needed for your journey.

CURRENCY CONTROL. The movement of money into and out of many countries is subject to Government control and you should consult your Travel Agent or Bank about regulations applicable to your journey well before the date of travel.

STOPOVERS. You may break your journey at most places en route without losing the benefit of the through fare, provided you give notice when you make the reservation. Hotel expenses at each stopover are your responsibility.

BAGGAGE. The free allowance which applies to each adult (or child paying half the adult fare) for International services is 20 Kg. and for U.K. Internal Services is 15 Kg. There is no free allowance for an infant carried at 10 per cent. of the adult fare, but infants' food for consumption en route and an infants' carrying basket is carried free of charge.

Personal items In addition to the free allowance, the following may be carried free of charge—a lady's handbag, an overcoat or wrap, a foot rug, an umbrella or walking stick, a small camera, a pair of binoculars and a reasonable amount of reading matter for the flight. Brief cases, typewriters and large cameras have to be included in the baggage weights under the regulations of the International Air Transport Association.

Excess Weight : Baggage in excess of the free allowance may be carried subject to space being available, at the rates shown in this timetable.

Unaccompanied Baggage : Unaccompanied baggage may be sent at normal cargo rates.

Prohibited Articles : Government regulations do not permit the carriage of inflammable or explosive material on aircraft and you are asked not to carry in your baggage articles which are easily ignited, such as cigarette lighter fluid, matches, etc. On most Hunting-Clan Air Transport aircraft smoking is permitted and you may carry a box of safety matches or a lighter with you for use on the journey.

N.B. Baggage should contain personal effects only, but you may carry commercial samples, provided you arrange to be at the airport for international flights not later than the time specified by the local Customs; in the United Kingdom this is 40 minutes before aircraft departure time.

CAMERAS. On International flights cameras must be packed in your checked baggage, which is not taken into the cabin with you.

DEPARTURES. You should assemble sufficiently early to allow embarkation formalities to be completed. On your ticket you will find the coach and aircraft departure times and an indication as to how long before these you should be at the town terminal or airport. Departure cannot be delayed for passengers who arrive late and Hunting-Clan Air Transport cannot accept responsibility in such cases.

PUNCTUALITY. Every effort is made to ensure punctuality of our services but Hunting-Clan Air Transport cannot accept responsibility for the consequences of a delay to, or a cancellation of, any flight and cannot guarantee making connections.

ROAD TRANSPORT. Road transport between town terminals and airports is normally available and is charged for separately.

MEALS. Light refreshments or meals are served free. At the principal airports buffet or restaurant facilities are available.

ANIMALS. We cannot carry any animal with the passenger, or as baggage. Livestock can be carried as cargo by arrangement.

CARGO. Hunting-Clan Air Transport provides rapid air freight service. Cargo is accepted for carriage on all routes.

VALIDITY OF TICKETS. All tickets including open date tickets are valid for 12 months from the date of commencement of flight except tickets sold at excursion or special fare rates.

RETURN TICKETS. If you hold a return ticket you are advised to confirm time of departure from our local office or Agents.
