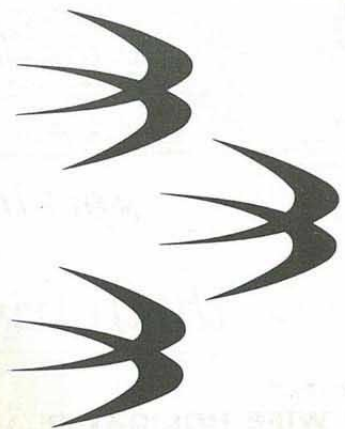

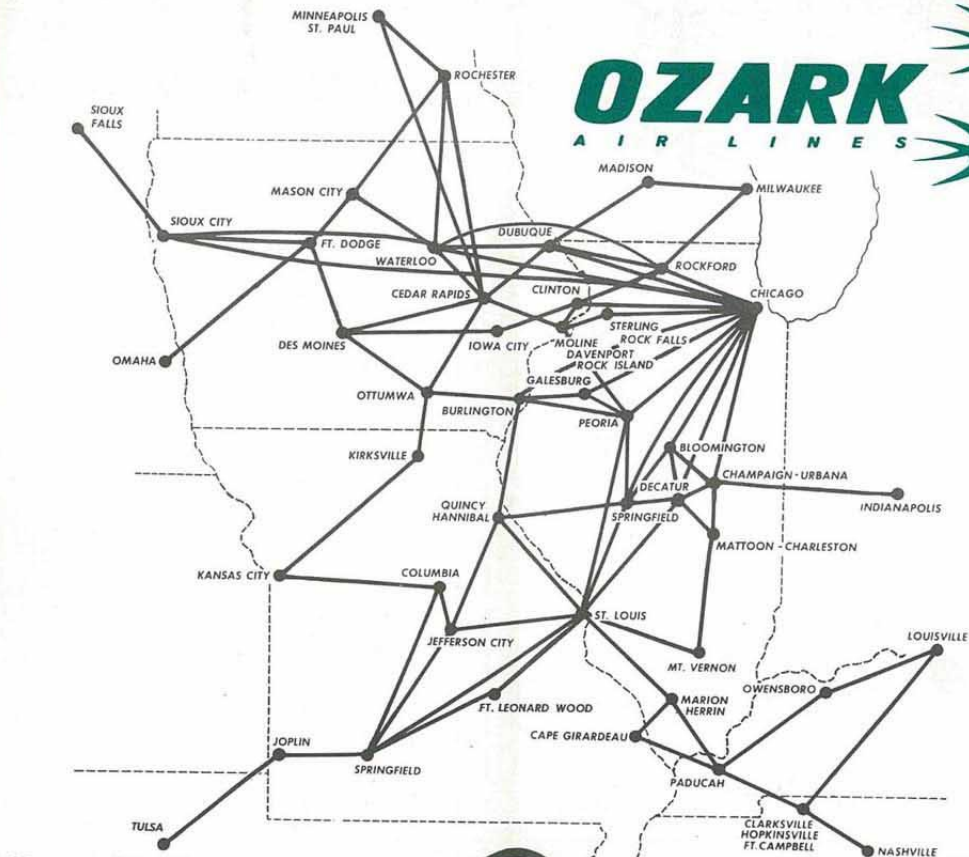

general information

DEPARTURES. Passengers are requested to be at airport ticket lifting points at LEAST 20 MINUTES before scheduled departure time. Reservations may be cancelled and resold if passenger has not presented himself for check-in at least 10 MINUTES before scheduled departure time.

RESPONSIBILITY FOR DEPARTURES, ARRIVALS, CONNECTIONS. Ozark Air Lines will not be responsible for damages resulting from the failure of flights to depart or arrive at times stated in this timetable, nor for errors herein, nor for failure to make connections with planes of other lines or of this Company. Schedules subject to change without notice.

SCHEDULES. Schedules shown are based on expected flying times. Because weather and other factors may affect operating conditions, departures and arrivals cannot be guaranteed.

BAGGAGE. Following rules apply:
FREE ALLOWANCE. within the United States and Canada is 40 pounds, international is 30 kilograms (66 pounds) for first class and 20 kilograms (44 pounds) for coach/tourist class transportation. The term "baggage" shall mean all luggage including briefcases, portfolios, parcels, camera equipment and similar articles whether carried in the cabin or checked in cargo compartment.

EXCESS BAGGAGE may be accepted, space and weight permitting. The following rate will apply, regardless of the type of service used by the passenger: One-half (1/2) of one percent of the full first class adult one-way fare per pound.
LIABILITY. Unless extra value is declared and charges paid before departure, liability is limited to \$100 or the actual value thereof, whichever is less.

CHILDREN

- (a) One child under 2 years, not occupying a seat, will be carried free with each accompanying adult passenger.
- (b) Children under 2 years, occupying a seat; or over 2 years and under 5 years; will be charged one-half the adult fare and must be accompanied by a passenger at least 12 years old.
- (c) Children 5 years and under 12 years of age may travel unaccompanied and will be charged one-half the adult fare.

GROUND TRANSPORTATION. Scheduled facilities have been arranged for the convenience of passengers. Ozark itself does not operate and has no liability for such service.
RESERVATIONS. All seats are reserved, and a reservation is tentative until a confirmed ticket has been purchased. Passengers are urged to make reservations and purchase tickets well in advance.
