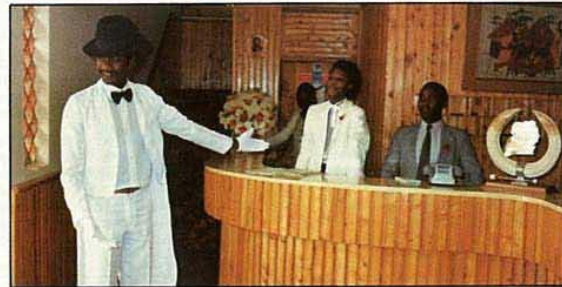

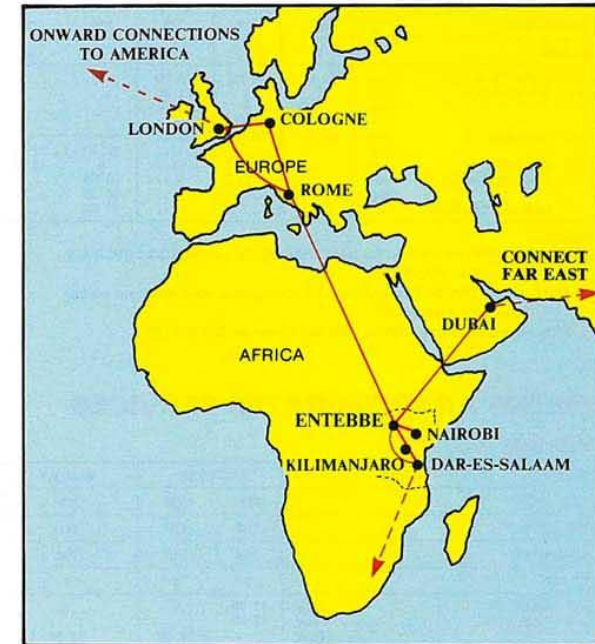

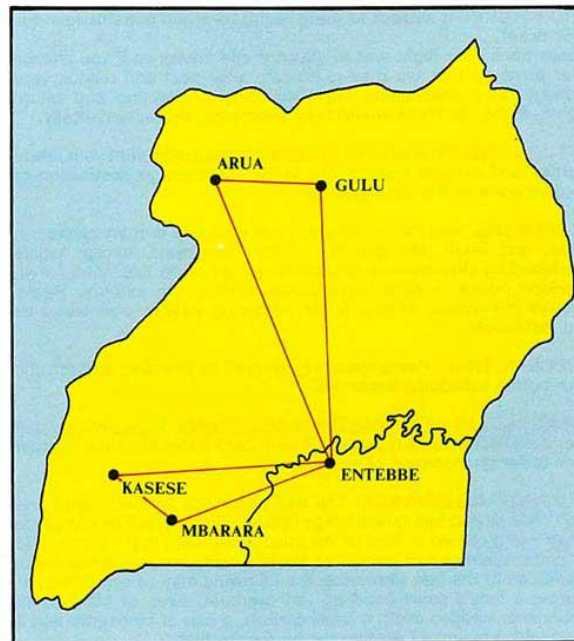

GENERAL PASSENGER INFORMATION

The following information is given as a quick guide but full details pertaining to the **CONDITIONS OF CARRIAGE** and tariff regulations applicable for your flights may be obtained from your travel agent or Uganda Airlines offices.

YOUR TICKET is subject to these regulations and extracts found in your ticket.

Please book your flight well in advance and advise us if you change your plans so that we may re-allocate your seat and rebook your passage on a subsequent flight including connecting and return flights, if any, as these would have been cancelled automatically.

RETURN AND ONWARD BOOKINGS: Please reconfirm your return journey and onward reservations within 72 hours at destination or transfer point as the case may be.

STOPOVERS: You may break your journey at one or more places, en route, and retain the benefit of the throughfare, except where precluded by Government regulations, or on some Excursion Fares, provided notice is given before commencing the journey. Please observe the entries, in your ticket, regarding validity, endorsements and restrictions.

CHECK-IN TIME: Passengers are required to check-in at least one hour before scheduled departure.

IMMIGRATION AND HEALTH REGULATIONS: Please ensure that your travel documents (passport, health certificates etc.) are in order prior to commencement of your journey.

BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE: The free allowance for each adult and each child paying half fare is 20kgs (44lbs). There is no free allowance for an infant carried at 10% of the adult fare except that infant's food for consumption en route and an infant's carry cot are carried free. In addition to the free allowance, the following may be carried free of charge; a lady's small handbag, an overcoat, wrap or blanket, an umbrella or walking stick, a small camera, a pair of binoculars and a reasonable amount of reading matter for the flight.

EXCESS BAGGAGE: Baggage exceeding the free baggage allowance may be transported as Excess Baggage, for which the rates are available at our Sales Offices and Airport of Embarkation.

IN-FLIGHT SAFETY requires that inflammable liquids, compressed gases, corrosives and even matches **must not be packed in baggage.**

GENERAL INFORMATION

Tourism/Wildlife

Winston Churchill named Uganda "The pearl of Africa" a sobriquet we heartily accept.

The country lies astride the equator, covering an area of 243,400 sq. km. of which about 44,080 sq. km. are open water and swamp. Most of the country is 1220m above sea level. It is spectacularly beautiful with a striking variety of scenery ranging from the mountains of the moon (Rwenzoris) to the arid plains of Karamoja. It is endowed with rich, fertile valleys, towering snow-capped peaks, magnificent lakes and waterfalls, dense forests and vast plains teeming with an abundance of varied wild game.

Temperatures remain pleasant due to the altitude and low humidity level. It seldom rises above 85°F or falls below 60°F. A well distributed rainfall, average 50" a year, keeps the country lush and green all the year round.

Tourist attractions are based on the country's scenic beauties and varied wildlife. Its favourable climate permits and motivates a continuous flow of tourists but the most popular seasons are December to March and June to September.

The country is accessible by air and is served internationally by the national airline—Uganda Airlines—and by several other foreign airlines. The road and rail transport, both within and to the country, is good and popular.

All visitors to Uganda are required to be in possession of a valid International Certificate of inoculation against cholera and yellow fever. Every courtesy and facility is extended to visitors arriving in Uganda, with minimum frontier formalities. All visitors to Uganda, except those from countries with which the country has a visa abolition agreement, require visas which are obtainable from any of Uganda's Diplomatic Missions abroad or directly on application to the Immigration Department, P.O. Box 7165, Kampala, Uganda. There are also numerous tour operators in Uganda who can cost an all-inclusive tour programme to suit your convenience and choice.

Uganda's four National Parks are the country's most popular attractions. These are the homes of some of the world's rare animal species. The amazing concentration of game and the innumerable colourful birds make a visit to any of them a most thrilling and unforgettable experience.

Murchison Falls National Park, the largest and most popular, covers 3900 sq. km. of north-western Uganda. Within it is the mighty Murchison Falls where the River Nile hurls itself with awesome power and plunges forty metres in one breath-taking leap. A launch trip on the Nile to the foot of the falls satisfies any photographer as the hippos, crocodiles, elephants, giraffes, birds and other species parade along the bank of the river. Nothing like this exists elsewhere in Africa! The accommodation and catering units are Paraa Lodge in the centre, Chobe Lodge in the eastern sector and Pakuba Lodge in the western area.

Queen Elizabeth National Park stretches 2500 sq. km. in south-western Uganda. An area rich in contrast with lakes, swamps, forests and savannahs being overlooked by the fabled mountains of the moon. Animal species in this park include hippos, elephants, large herds of topi, Uganda kob, etc. and in the Park's southern sector lies the Ishasha area famous for its tree climbing lions while in Maramagambo Forest, which divides it from the northern area, can be found chimpanzees, the black and white colobus monkeys and other unusual animals. The principal accommodation unit is Mweya Safari Lodge.

Kidepo Valley National Park lies in the northernmost extremity of Karamoja region in the north-east of Uganda. It covers an area of 1400 sq. km. with scenery unsurpassed in beauty by any other park in East Africa. In contrast to animal species found in the other three National Parks, one finds zebra, kudu, gazelle, dikdik, cheetah and roan antelope. A 32 room rest camp at Apoka offers comfortable accommodation.

Lake Mburo National Park is situated in the south-west of Uganda not far from the thriving community of Mbarara dependant on agriculture and cattle farming for their buoyant economic activity. It has recently been gazetted as a National Park and covers 536 sq. km. Its landscape consists of open plains in the north, a middle belt of acacia grass and a marshy, forested zone around the lakes. An even distribution of fauna consisting of oribi, zebra, topi, impala, klipspringer, reedbuck, warthog and eland as well as lions roaming by the lakes exemplifies how Lake Mburo National Park is unique.

Uganda as a birth place of the historic and mighty Nile has other varied attractions well distributed throughout the country. These include folklore festivals, archeological sites, tombs of kings of the past, historical monuments, places of worship, earthworks and a variety of traditional dances which are the most rhythmic in the world. The prevailing rich tradition of craftsmanship mirrors Uganda's unique personality and any visitor to this famed land will prove it as an opened book of history and indeed an ancient one within the present—Uganda is 'the pearl of Africa'.
