The annual Moscow stars Festival of Russian and Soviet music is held in Moscow (May 5-13). It includes best opera and ballet performances, symphonic, instrumental and vocal music compositions.

The Russian Winter Festival is held in Moscow (December 25 to January 5). The festival programme includes music, songs and dances of the peoples of the USSR, performances by variety companies and the famous Soviet circus. Wonderful New Year celebrations – a winter holiday sparkling with gaiety in Moscow, Leningrad, Novgorod, Vladimir, Suzdal, Irkutsk...

The White Nights Festival held in Leningrad (June 21–29) is dedicated to classical ballet and folk dances.

The Kiev Spring Festival is held in Kiev (May 20–30). The best musical companies from the fraternal Union Republics take part in this festival.

The Melodies of the Soviet Transcaucasian Festival (October 5–13) is held annually in one of the capitals of Soviet Transcaucasian Republics – Baku, Tbilisi or Yerevan. The Byelorussian Musical Autumn Festival is held in Minsk (November 20–30). The Mertsishor Festival held in Kishinev (March 1–10) covers classical, folk and variety music of Moldavia.




