

INFORMATION TO PASSENGERS

RESERVATIONS

Airlines do not normally undertake to reserve seats in any particular position in the aircraft.

COACHES

In most cases the coach journeys may be omitted from the itinerary, if requested. Details of connecting coaches to and from the provinces may be obtained on request.

FARES

1. Passengers taking midweek return tickets to Paris but wishing to return by weekend flights will be charged the sum of half the return fares applicable to each flight in respect of the London Paris service.
2. All special (2-day excursion) fares shown are saleable only in countries of original departure and turn round.
3. A *reduction in fare* is granted for group travel (10 or more adult members of sports clubs, social or similar groups) when travelling together to the same destination. Details may be obtained on application.
4. Children under the age of two years at date of commencement of journey, accompanied by an adult and not occupying a separate seat will be charged 10% of the adult fare.
5. Children of two years and under twelve years of age at date of commencement of journey, will be charged 50% of the adult fare.
6. A refund of fare cannot be guaranteed for a reservation cancelled or transferred at short notice. A passenger failing to join the flight on which he is booked, will incur a forfeiture of 25% of the single fare. (Minimum charge of £2, or full fare if less than £2.)
7. *Special reduced fares* are available for students over 12 years and under 26 years of age, attending full time school, college university courses or other educational institutes, when travelling between places of education and home. Full information obtainable on request.
8. All fares and rates shown in this time-table are subject to alteration without notice.
9. Except when otherwise stated, all fares shown are Tourist Class fares.

REPORTING TIMES

Passengers must "check in" sufficiently early to allow formalities to be completed. On your ticket you will find the coach and aircraft departure time and an indication (normally 30 minutes before departure) as to how long before these times you should be at the town terminal or airport. Departures cannot be delayed for passengers who arrive late, and Skyways cannot accept responsibility in such cases.

PASSPORTS AND VISAS

Skyways or its agents will gladly provide on request information regarding passports or any visas required for your journey, but you must ensure personally that these documents are in order, because the carrier cannot accept responsibility for any irregularity or consequences of any irregularity. You will have to show your passport during your journey, so please carry it with you—do not pack it!

CURRENCY CONTROL

The movement of money into and out of many countries is subject to Government control, and you should consult your travel agent or Bank well before date of travel about regulations applicable to your journey.

CARS

There is a covered car park at Lympne Airport for the convenience of passengers. Cars may be serviced if desired. Full details of these facilities are obtainable on request.

BAGGAGE

1. Free allowance 44 lbs. (20 kg.). Infants under two years old, nil.
2. Passengers are asked to restrict their baggage to cases of reasonable dimensions.
3. In addition to the free allowance, the following may be carried free of charge—A lady's handbag, an overcoat or wrap, a foot rug, an umbrella or walking stick, a small camera, a pair of binoculars, an invalid's fully collapsible wheel chair, and a reasonable amount of reading matter for the flight, infants food for consumption en route and infants carrying basket. Brief cases, typewriters and large cameras have to be included in the baggage weights under the Regulations of the International Air Transport Association.
4. Baggage in excess of the free allowance may be carried subject to space being available, at the rates shown in the timetable.
5. Government regulations do not permit of a number of articles including inflammable or explosive material, and you are asked not to carry in your baggage articles which are easily ignited, such as cigarette lighter fuel, matches, etc. On most Skyways aircraft smoking is permitted, and you may carry a box of *safety* matches or a lighter with you for use on the journey.
6. Baggage should contain personal effects only, but you may carry commercial samples providing you arrange to be at the airport not later than the time specified by the local Customs; in the United Kingdom this is 40 minutes before departure times.

REFRESHMENTS

Details of refreshments available for each of Skyways services may be obtained on request. On short flights coffee and biscuits are normally served.

INSURANCE

Personal and baggage insurance may be purchased at our Airport in the United Kingdom.

PUNCTUALITY

Every effort is made to ensure punctuality of our services, but Skyways cannot accept responsibility for the consequences of a delay to or cancellation of any flight at whatever notice, and cannot guarantee making connections.

ALTERATIONS TO AND CANCELLATION OF SCHEDULES
