**ALL TIMES LOCAL**

**First day:**

Departure from Jan Smuts Airport (Johannesburg) at 5 a.m. via N'dola (North Rhodesia) (breakfast) to Entebbe (Uganda) at Lake Victoria arriving appr. 4 p.m. for the first nightstop in Lake Victoria Hotel on the Lake, rightly known as the "Pearl of Africa."

**Second Day:**

Departure from Entebbe at 6.30 a.m., straight through to Khartoum where lunch is served at the newly built airport. Departure from Khartoum to Wadi Halfa where we arrive at 4 p.m. for the second night stop. Passengers may then tour Wadi Halfa, sail on the Nile and/or visit ancient temples.

**Third Day:**

Departure from Wadi Halfa will be at 5 a.m. on the third day. The next stop will normally be Athens, where lunch will be served. An aerial view of the famous Acropolis will be had on leaving Athens for the next nightstop, which will be Rome or Malta. On the way to Rome we give you the view of Mount Vesuvius and the Bay of Naples. Eighteen hours are spent in Rome, which gives the traveller a useful amount of time for sightseeing, and a memorable night in the "City of Dreams".

**Fourth Day:**

Departure from Rome at 9 a.m. En route, the Alps will come into view on the righthand side. Arrival at Luxembourg at 1.30 p.m. Luxembourg is a beautifully situated mediaeval city, with excellent Air and Rail connections for Paris, Brussels, Amsterdam, London, Hamburg, Frankfurt, Dusseldorf, Cologne, Munich, Zurich, etc.

**GROUND TRANSPORT.** This is provided free in Johannesburg and en route, but not at European termini.

**HEALTH DOCUMENTS.** Passengers must be in possession of valid International Health certificates stating that they have been vaccinated against Yellow Fever and Smallpox. The International Sanitary Regulations specify the following periods for the validity of International Certificates of vaccination.

TYPE	CERTIFICATE VALID FOR	PERIOD OF VALIDITY BEGINS
Yellow Fever Primary	6 years	after 10 days
" " Revaccination within 6 years	6 years	immediately
Smallpox Primary	3 years	after 8 days
" " Revaccination	3 years	immediately

**PASSPORTS AND VISAS.** Air Companies are not allowed to carry passengers whose documents are not in order. In order to travel from one country to another, you must in most cases have a valid passport and a visa in some cases. While we normally have available all the latest information, regulations change from time to time without notice and we cannot be held responsible for the accuracy of our information and suggest that you consult the nearest consulate of the country you intend to visit in order to obtain proper advice. Only passengers with South African Passports require a transit visa for Rome, our third nightstop.

**CURRENCY.** Currency control is exercised by the Governments of many countries, and changes are made frequently. Your Bankers have complete information, and they will also assist you by issuing Traveller Cheques, Letters of Credit, or Bank Drafts. The latest information we have available is as follows:

**BAGGAGE.** The free baggage allowance is:

Adults—20 kilos (44 lbs).  
Children—10 kilos (22 lbs).  
Infants NIL.

All baggage must be weighed including brief cases, overnight bags, hat boxes, typewriters, large cameras, etc. The only exceptions are: lady's handbag, an overcoat or wrap, umbrella or walking stick, small camera, reasonable amount reading matter, pair binoculars, an infants food for consumption en-route, and an infants carrying basket or bassinot.

**Excess:** Excess luggage may be carried, subject to space being available, at 10/- per lb. (22/- per kilo).

Baggage which will not be required during flight should be packed separately from the nightstop baggage, and labelled accordingly. Passengers are advised to have a change of light clothing in their nightstop baggage for use in tropical areas.

**INSURANCE:** No responsibility can be accepted by the Company for any loss of, or damage to passengers baggage or personal property. It is recommended that insurance be taken out for baggage and personal accident cover which can be arranged in our offices.

**N.B.** Passengers are automatically covered by insurance for £3,000—(Life)
