The aircraft employed by WESTERN AIRWAYS are De Havilland Dragons, sumptuously fitted. Engine failures are things of the past, but it is interesting to note that these machines will continue in flight, with one engine stopped, so that there is no chance of forced landings. Every machine is inspected every day by engineers licenced by the Air Ministry. SAFETY FIRST is WESTERN AIRWAYS slogan. Your first trip in one of these machines will be a revelation—there is no sensation of speed, and, contrary to the general impression, height will not affect you. Looking at the ground from an aeroplane is like looking at a map. Air sickness is much publicised—but actually cases are very infrequent—far less than sea sickness.

Try a flight—say from Weston to Cardiff (it's even cheaper than going by train)—sit back in the luxurious chairs, and watch the magnificent view rolling slowly beneath your gaze. Keep your cigarette on, and turning left look at the vast expanse of the Bristol Channel, the Quantock Hills and Exmoor in the distance, the South Wales coast, Bridgwater Bay and the plains of Avalon. Underneath, the islands of Steep Holm and Flat Holm, whilst northwards the diminishing estuary of the Severn, the mountains of Wales, the Cotswolds, and on clear days, the Malvern Hills. Before your cigarette is finished you will be gliding down to a smooth landing at Cardiff—a traveller converted to air travel.

ROAD TRANSPORT

WESTON-SUPER-MARE.

A special coach operated by Bristol Tramways & Carriage Co., Ltd., for WESTERN AIRWAYS leaves the Beach Bus Station for the Airport and collects passengers, fifteen services a day. These services connect with arrivals and departures of all Western Airways planes. Transport free to passengers travelling on air lines, charge for parties accompanying passengers or proceeding to Airport, 6d. per head single.

CARDIFF.

No. 34 Service. Cardiff Corporation Buses.
A twelve minute frequency service of Cardiff Corporation buses leaves Kingsway and Queen Street for the Airport. Fare 2½d. single. These services connect with arrivals and departures of WESTERN AIRWAYS planes.

BRISTOL.

A special coach operated by Bristol Tramways & Carriage Co., Ltd., for WESTERN AIRWAYS leaves the Tramways Centre 25 minutes before plane departure. Connects all arrivals and departures. Transport free to passengers travelling on air lines. Charge for parties accompanying passengers or proceeding to Airport, 1/- single per head.
