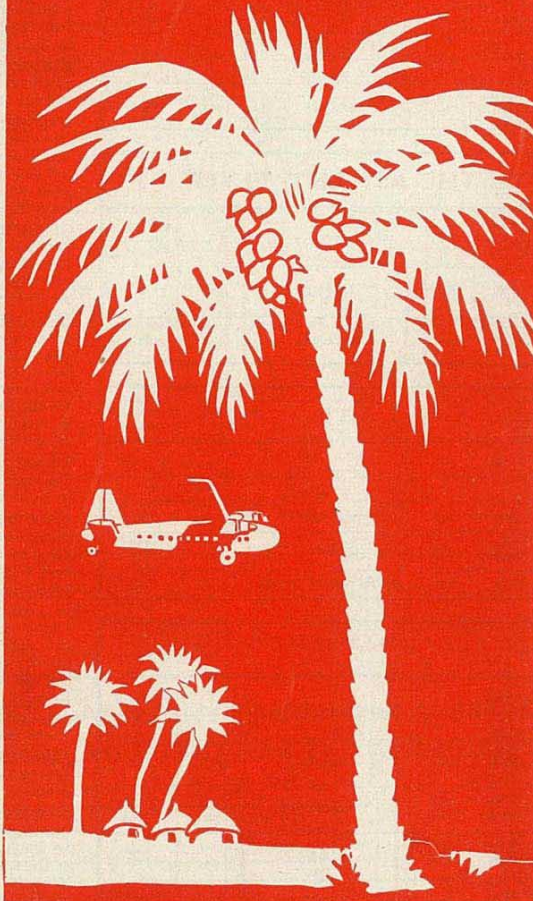

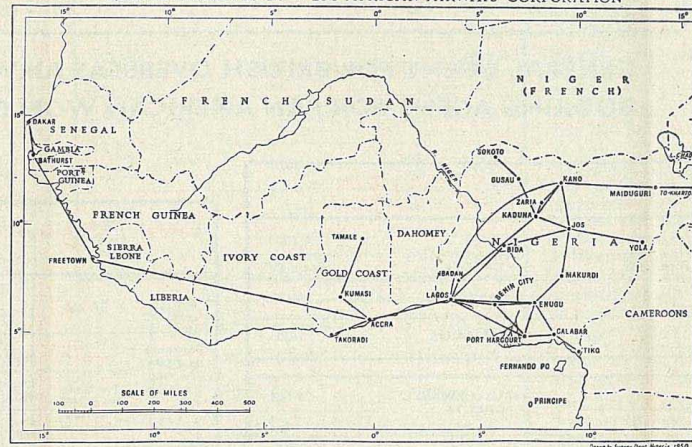

AIR CARGO & PARCELS. West African Airways Corporation accepts air cargo and parcels for carriage, provided they do not fall within the list of articles which are prohibited for carriage by air; details of these may be obtained upon request. They are also subject to size and weight limitations. Special rebates are allowed on bulk consignments.

BAGGAGE. The free allowance of baggage for adults mentioned below is 30 kilos (66 lbs.). In addition, overcoats, rugs and wraps, umbrellas, walking sticks, small pocket cameras, ladies' hand-bags and binoculars, may be carried free of charge. Free baggage allowances for two or more passengers travelling together may be bulked.

BREAK OF JOURNEY. A break of journey is permitted on certain services provided the ticket is endorsed at the time of booking. The validity of the ticket remains unchanged.

CANCELLATIONS. When the single fare is less than £25, the deadline for cancellation is 48 hours before the scheduled departure of the service. Full cancellation fees will be imposed after this period of notice amounting to the full value of the single ticket. If the single fare is £25 or more, notice of cancellation must be given within 72 hours prior to the scheduled departure of the service, otherwise a fee of 25% of the single fare, or £25 (whichever is the greater) will be imposed.

CHARTER AIRCRAFT. De Havilland Dove aircraft having seating accommodation for 8 passengers over short distances, may be chartered at reasonable rates. Aircraft are also available at short notice for ambulance duties, whilst stretcher cases may also be accommodated on the scheduled services subject to the condition of the patient.

CHILDREN. Children under two years of age, when accompanied by an adult, are charged 10% of the adult fare. Only one infant may accompany each adult at this rate. Children between 2 and 12 years of age (or infants in excess of one per adult) are carried at half the adult fare. The age limits referred to are taken as at the date of commencement of the outward journey. A free baggage allowance of 30 kilos (66 lbs.) is available for children over two years of age but there is no free allowance for infants unless they pay half the adult fare. A portable cradle may be included in the personal weight of the infant.

CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT. An extract from the General Conditions of Contract may be found in every air ticket. A complete copy of the General Conditions of Contract may be inspected at any Airport of call.

CONNECTIONS. Whilst every endeavour is made to ensure the punctuality of services, West African Airways Corporation cannot accept responsibility for any delay to or suspension of its services, and does not guarantee connections with its own or other Companies' services.

DEPARTURES. Passengers must arrive at the Airport of departure 20 minutes in advance of the advertised departure time for internal services, and 30 minutes before departure for the intercolonial services, in order to complete baggage and weighing-in formalities. No service can be delayed for passengers whose arrival leaves insufficient time for these formalities to be completed and a forfeiture of the fare will be made.

FARES. All fares are subject to alteration without notice and are quoted from Airport to Airport, surface transport not normally being provided nor included in the fare.

INSURANCE. West African Airways Corporation enjoys the privilege of being able to offer insurance at the favourable rates allowed to the large international airlines.

RESERVATIONS. There is a heavy demand for accommodation on all services and intending passengers are recommended to reserve seats well in advance. Firm bookings can only be accepted upon payment of the full fare. *The cost of any telegrams or trunk telephone calls in connection with the bookings are charged to the passenger.* West African Airways Corporation in its capacity as an agent for the principal airlines will be pleased to assist in effecting air reservations to any part of the world.

RETURN TICKETS. Return tickets for direct routes are issued at double the single fare, less 20% of the single fare. *A passenger holding a return ticket is not entitled to any priority and must make a return reservation in the normal manner.* To secure the reduction allowed on return tickets, the return fare must be paid when the outward ticket is purchased. If a passenger is unable to use the return half of the ticket, the difference between the single and return fare will be refunded provided the regulations governing cancellation have been observed.

SECOND CLASS FARES. On certain services second class fares have been introduced. These services are operated by 56 seater Bristol Freighter aircraft.

STEWARD SERVICE. On services operated by Bristol Wayfarer aircraft a bar and steward service are available for the convenience of passengers.
